
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC - 62

Coleoptera: Erotylidae

Dacne picta Crotch, 1873. Bohemia centr., Praha- Ďáblice (5852), 26. ix. 1993, 1 spec. in rests of an unidentified bracket-fungus (Polyporales) beside an oak stem in the Ďáblice grove, P.Štourač leg. and coll., J.Jelínek det. This species occurs in the Maritime Province of Russia (Primorie) and Japan (Krivolutskaya 1992) and, as adventive species, in Hawaii (Schmidl (1995) according to Chujo (1969)). Since 1993 it has been repeatedly collected in Erlangen, Germany, where it developed in fruiting bodies of *Laetiporus sulphureus* (Bull. ex Fr.) Murrill (Schmidl 1995). The present record from Bohemia suggests that *Dacne picta* may have become more widely established in Central Europe.
