Coleoptera: Staphylinidae

Atheta (Atheta) heymesi Hubenthal, 1913. Bohemia bor., Krušné hory Mts., Grünwaldské rašeliniště peatbog (5348), 1000 m, 12.-13.iv.1998, 1 ♂, J. Farkač lgt., T. Jászay det., coll. Museum of Šariš, Bardejov. The specimen was taken in the peatbog in a yellow pan-trap. The species is distributed in Germany (Thüringen, Mittelbe, Sachsen, Hessen, Rheinland, Harz), Austria (Tirol, Steiermark) and North Italy (Benick & Lohse 1974, Ciceroni et al. 1995, Horion 1951, Koch 1989). New species for the Czech Republic.
