
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 106

Coleoptera: Staphylinidae: Aleocharinae

Autalia longicornis Scheerpeltz, 1947. Moravia mer.: Lednice – park (7166), 26.v.1986, 2 ♂♂, 1 ♀, sifted from old fruiting body of *Polyporus squamosus*; Podyjí National Park, 1 km SE of Zadní Hamry, Ledové sluje (7161a), 300 m a.s.l., 19.vi.-11.xi.1994, 1 ♂, baited pitfall trap, margin of a deciduous forest. All J. Růžicka leg. et coll., S. Snäll det. Mycophilous species, known from Spain, France, England, Denmark, Sweden, Norway, Finland, Germany, Italy, Poland, Slovakia, Slovenia, Bosnia, Romania, Greece and Cyprus (Silfverberg 1992, Assing 1997). From the Czech Republic reported only from Bohemia (Likovský 1993). New species for Moravia.

Autalia puncticollis Sharp, 1864. Moravia mer., Uherské Hradiště (6970), 2.viii.1996, 1 ♀, alley of *Tilia* sp. on a bank of the Morava river, pitfall trap (baited with cheese), J. Růžicka leg. et coll., S. Snäll det. The species is known from Scotland, France, Switzerland, Denmark, Norway, Sweden, Finland, Germany, Italy, Austria, Slovakia, Poland, Latvia, Lithuania, Estonia and Karelia, introduced also to North America (Silfverberg 1992, Assing 1997). New species for the Czech Republic.
