
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 113

Coleoptera: Anobiidae

Lasioderma kiesenwetteri Schilsky, 1899. Moravia mer., Břeclav (7267), 19.vii.1995, 1 ♂, P. Macháček lgt. et coll., P. Zahradník det. Distributed in south-eastern Europe, Asia Minor and Central Asia (Logvinovskiy 1985, Zahradník 1998); Lucht (1987) reported it from the former Czechoslovakia without giving precise data. Based on study of large material from museums and private collections, Zahradník (1993) only regarded its occurrence in the Czech Republic and Slovakia as possible. The first reliable record from the Czech Republic; occurrence in the Czech Republic confirmed.
