
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 92

Lepidoptera: Tortricidae

Sparganothis rubicundana (Herrich-Schäffer, 1856). Bohemia bor. or., Králický Sněžník Mt. (5767), 1426 m a.s.l., 17.vii.1999, 2 ♂♂, S. Helová & M. Konvička lgt., J. Beneš det. et coll. Captured flying at the alpine meadow on the summit of the Králický Sněžník Mt. Widely distributed in Northern Europe, relict distribution in Central Europe confined to the Hrubý Jeseník Mts. (recently also confirmed) and to Králický Sněžník Mt., Eastern Sudetes (Skala 1913, Razowski 1981, Novák et al. 1997). Occurrence in Bohemia confirmed after a century.
