
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 124

Hymenoptera: Chrysididae

Stilbum cyanurum (Förster, 1771). Bohemia centr., Praha-Nové Město, Viničná 7 (close to the Botanical Garden) (5952), 1.-14.vi.2000, 1 dead spec. at a window sill in the Faculty of Sciences (Charles University) building, D. Král lgt., J. Batelka det. et coll. The specimen has green abdomen. The species is distributed in all geographical regions (except of American continent), in the Czech Republic known only from southern parts of Moravia (Balthasar 1954, Pádr 1989); missing in check list of Aculeata of Praha (Pádr 1990). Due to collection circumstances autochthony of the specimen is questionable. First record from Bohemia.
