
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 140

Coleoptera: Eucnemidae

Farsus dubius (Piller et Mitterpacher, 1783). Moravia mer., Břeclav env., Pohansko (7267), 5.viii.1996, 1 ♀, I. Martinů (Olomouc) leg. and coll., J. Vávra det.; ditto, 7.viii.1996, 1 ♂, P. Macháček leg., J. Mertlik det. and coll.; ditto, 27.vi.-1.vii.1997, 1 ♂, I. Martinů leg. and coll., J. Vávra det. Distributed in southern Europe and southern part of central Europe, reaching Syria and the Caucasus in the east (Horion 1953, Burakowski 1991). In central Europe reported only from Austria (Horion 1953). New species for the Czech Republic.

Microrhagus (Emyirhagus) emyi (Rouget, 1855). Bohemia or., Česká Skalice env., Dubno Nature Reserve (5562), 9.vi.1999, 6 ♂♂, M. Mikát leg. and det., J. Vávra revid., coll. M. Mikát (3 ♂♂), J. Vávra (1 ♂) and Museum of Eastern Bohemia (Hradec Králové) (2 ♂♂); ditto, 11.vi.1999, 5 ♂♂, 1 ♀, M. Mikát leg. et det., coll. J. Krátký (Hradec Králové) (1 ♂), J. Mertlik (1 ♂) and Museum of Eastern Bohemia (3 ♂♂, 1 ♀); ditto, 17.vii.1999, 1 ♀; ditto, 25.v.2000, 1 ♂, both M. Mikát leg., det. et coll. All specimens were captured on clearings and in open woodland by sweeping in the afternoon. Distributed sporadically in central and southern Europe, known also from southern Sweden and the Caucasus (Burakowski et al. 1985, Burakowski 1991). In central Europe very few records from Germany, northern Switzerland, Austria, Hungary, Slovakia and the Ukraine so far known (Horion 1953, Burakowski 1991); the species has been recorded in Poland (Lucht 1992, Burakowski et al. 2000), but without concrete records. From the Czech Republic reported only from southern Moravia (Olexa 1993, Vávra 1996). New species for Bohemia.
