
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 150

Coleoptera: Curculionidae

Tychius pusillus Germar, 1842. Bohemia or., Radvanice – Paseka (5462), 3.v.2001, 1 ♀, on *Trifolium* sp., A. Hamet lgt., det. and coll., J. Fremuth and J. Strejček revid. The species has been known in the former Czechoslovakia only from Slovakia (Strejček 1993). The record from southern Bohemia (Vyšenské kopce hills nr. Český Krumlov) by Strejček (1976) was based on misidentified specimens of *Tychius sharpi* Tournier, 1873 (J. Strejček, pers. comm. 2002) and therefore the species was not listed in the Check-list (Strejček 1993). New species for the Czech Republic.
