
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 160

Coleoptera: Chrysomelidae

Psylliodes laticollis Kutschera, 1864. Moravia bor., Karlova Studánka (5669), 29.vii.2002, 1 ♂, sweeping of vegetation near a stream, M. Zúber leg., det. et coll. Known from west and south Europe (Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, England, France incl. Corsica, Germany, Greece – Ionian Islands and Crete, Italy incl. Sardinia and Sicily, Luxembourg, the Netherlands, Spain, Switzerland), North Africa (Algeria, Morocco, Tunisia) and Atlantic Islands (Cape Verde Islands, Madeira). In central Europe known only from Slovakia (Gruev & Döberl 1997). Majzlan (1999) reported this species from Slovakia under the name *P. weberi* Lohse, 1955. New species for the Czech Republic.

Sphaeroderma rubidum (Gräells, 1858). Bohemia centr., between Sadská and Kersko (5855), 2.vi.2002, 2 spec., M. Zúber leg., det. et coll. European species known also from North Africa, Asia Minor and Caucasus (Gruev & Döberl 1997). From the Czech Republic reported from Moravia by Strejček (1993). New species for Bohemia.
