

***Psammotisia* nom. nov., a new replacement name for *Tisia* Hoberlandt, 1993
(Heteroptera: Pentatomidae: Sciocorini)**

***Psammotisia* nom. nov., nové náhradní jméno pro *Tisia* Hoberlandt, 1993
(Heteroptera: Pentatomidae: Sciocorini)**

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Abstract. *Tisia* Hoberlandt, 1993 (Heteroptera: Pentatomidae: Sciocorini) is recognized as junior homonym of *Tisia* Dlabola, 1981 (Fulgoroidea: Flatidae). A new replacement name, *Psammotisia* nom. nov., is proposed for *Tisia* Hoberlandt, 1993 to remove the homonymy. A new combination, *Psammotisia gracilis* (Hoberlandt, 1993), comb. nov., is established.

Dlabola (1981: 192) established a new genus *Tisia* to accommodate a newly described species *Tisia esfandiarii* Dlabola, 1981 of the family Flatidae. Later, Hoberlandt (1993: 15-16) used the name *Tisia* for his new genus of the tribe Sciocorini, family Pentatomidae, including a single species *Tisia gracilis* Hoberlandt, 1993. Both authors derived the name from the type locality – Tis, a small village in south-eastern Iran. *Tisia* Hoberlandt, 1993 is thus a junior homonym of *Tisia* Dlabola, 1981. Type specimens of both *T. esfandiarii* Dlabola, 1981 and *T. gracilis* Hoberlandt, 1993 are kept in the collections of National Museum, Prague, Czech Republic.

A new name, *Psammotisia* nom. nov., is proposed for *Tisia* Hoberlandt, 1993 to remove the homonymy. The new name is derived from the original name adding the Greek prefix psammo- (= sand-), which reminds the peculiar psammophilous way of life (see Hoberlandt 1993) of the only known species of the genus – *Psammotisia gracilis* (Hoberlandt, 1993), comb. nov.

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SOUHRN

Tisia Hoberlandt, 1993 (Heteroptera: Pentatomidae: Sciocorini) je mladším homonymem jména *Tisia* Dlabola, 1981 (Fulgoromorpha: Flatidae). *Psammotisia* nom. nov. je navrženo jako nové náhradní jméno pro *Tisia* Hoberlandt, 1993; je vytvořena jedna nová kombinace – *Psammotisia gracilis* (Hoberlandt, 1993), comb. nov.
