
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 216

Coleoptera: Ochodaeidae

Codocera ferruginea (Eschscholtz, 1818). Moravia mer., Dyjákovičky – Ječmeniště (7162), 28.vii.2005, 1 ♂, 1 ♀, at light, around midnight, J. Hlášek & R. Stejskal lgt., V. Křivan det. et coll., 26.vi.2006, 1 ♂, at light, ca at 23:30, Z. Kraus lgt., det. et coll.; all specimens collected in steppe-like grassland loess soil. Widespread species of open steppe and steppe-like habitats; distributed in Central Europe, the Balkans, southern parts of European Russia, the Ukraine including the Crimea, Kazakhstan, Middle Asia, Central Asia, southern Siberia, northern parts of China (Xinjiang) and Russian Far East (e. g. Bunalski & Guéourguiev 2004, López-Colón et al. 2006, Nikolajev 1987, 1989). In Central Europe so far known from Austria (Burgenland) (Horion 1958), Hungary (e. g. Ádám 1994) and Slovakia (e. g. Gottwald 1969). Recorded also from Poland more than 100 years ago but not confirmed later on (Mroczkowski & Stefańska 1991). From the Czech Republic reported only without further details by Král (2006), based on the specimens above. First precise data from the Czech Republic.
