

FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 218

Coleoptera: Cerambycidae: Lamiinae

Morimus funereus (Mulsant, 1862). Moravia mer., Vedrovice (6964), 21.vi.2001, 1 ♂ on a sap-oozing wound of a living oak trunk, in a deer park, R. Sehnal lgt., det. and coll., O. Sabol revid. Mediterranean species, penetrating northward through the Pontic area (Heyrovský 1955). Distributed in south-eastern Europe, known from France (improbable according to Sama (2002)) to north-eastern Italy to the Balkans including Greece, eastward to Bulgaria, Romania, Moldova and the Ukraine (Sama 2002). In central Europe recently known from southern Austria, Hungary and Slovakia; old records known from Poland and Germany. Records from Switzerland require confirmation (Sama 2002). In the Czech Republic reported from Bohemia (Heyrovský 1930, Sláma 1998), with old records also from Moravia (Heyrovský 1930). Sláma (1998) reported a pre-1960 record from Jundrov in southern Moravia. The present record confirms the occurrence of this species in Moravia after at least 40 years.

Cardoria scutellata (Fabricius, 1792). Moravia mer., Pouzdřany (6964), 21.iv.1990, 1 ♀ swept from herbaceous vegetation, J. Toman lgt., det. and coll., V. Kubáň revid. Pontomediterranean species (Heyrovský 1955) distributed in central and south-eastern Europe, Asia Minor, Caucasus, Transcaucasia, and northern Iran (Sama 2002). In south-eastern Europe reported only from Serbia, Romania, Crimea and the southern part of European Russia (Sama 2002). In central Europe occurring in Germany (only old records – Horion (1974)), Austria, Slovakia, and Hungary (Sama 2002). In the Czech Republic sporadically recorded only in Moravia in the 19th century and the first half of the 20th century (Klug 1855, Fleischer 1927-1930, Heyrovský 1930, 1955). An additional record from the surroundings of Znojmo (Černý 1997) was not accompanied by any further data; according to M. Sláma (pers. comm.) the specimen was probably collected in 1970s. The present record confirms the occurrence of this species in the Czech Republic after at least 25 years.
