

FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 242

Hymenoptera: Pteromalidae

Xiphydriophagus meyerinckii (Ratzeburg, 1848). Bohemia mer., Majdalena env., Meandry Lužnice Nature Reserve (7055), 6 spec., reared from alder (*Alnus glutinosa*) logs infested by *Xiphydria camelus* (Linnaeus, 1758), stored under laboratory conditions since ii.2006, P. Šrůtka lgt., V. Kalina det., coll. O. Nakládal. A primary parasitoid of several species of the genus *Xiphydria* (Hymenoptera: Xiphydriidae), including *X. camelus* (Linnaeus, 1758) (Graham 1969, Herting 1977, Dzhanokmen 1978), *X. longicollis* (Geoffroy, 1785) (Bouček 1957, Thompson 1958, Dzhanokmen 1978), and *X. prolongata* (Geoffroy, 1785) (Dzhanokmen 1978, Graham 1969). A European species, known from Austria (Schimitschek 1935, Thompson 1958), Czech Republic (Graham 1969, Kalina 1989), Germany (many authors, e.g. Bouček 1957), France (Vago 1972), England (many authors, e.g. Bouček 1957), southern and central European Russia (Dzhanokmen 1978), Netherlands (Gijswijt 2003), and Sweden (Hansson 1991, Hedqvist 2003). Kalina (1989) mentioned it only from Moravia. New species for Bohemia.

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
