
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 301

Coleoptera: Cryptophagidae

Cryptophagus falcozi Roubal, 1927. Moravia bor.: Moravskoslezské Beskydy mts., Smrk Nature Reserve (6476), ca. 1000 m a. s. l., 19.vi.–2.vii.2008, 1 ♀; Moravskoslezské Beskydy mts., Razula National Nature Reserve (6676), ca. 700 m a.s.l.; 20.vi.–3.vii.2008, 1 ♀; both specimens in flight interception traps at 1.5 m above ground, saturated NaCl solution as preservative; both J. Schlaghamerský leg., P. Průdek det. and coll. European species, described from Slovakia (vicinity of Banská Bystrica), also reported from Denmark, Estonia, Great Britain, Italy, Slovakia, and Slovenia (Reška & Jelínek 1993, Johnson et al. 2007). **New species for the Czech Republic.**
