
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 358

Coleoptera: Sphindidae

Aspidiphorus lareyniei Jacquelin du Val, 1859. Moravia mer., Podyjí National Park, Znojmo env., Popice (7162), 13.v.2013, 1 spec., beaten from a dead branch of *Quercus* sp. in Popická pařezina forest, O. Konvička leg. et coll., J. Vávra det. According to Jelínek (2007), the species is known from Azerbaijan, Austria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, France, Italy, Romania, Russia: South European Territory, Slovakia and Slovenia. It has also been reported recently from Ukraine (Mateleshko 2009) and Spain (Viñolas et al. 2012). In the Czech Republic recorded only from Bohemia, from Praha-Zbraslav by Snäll (2007). New species for Moravia.
