

Corrigendum

Fery (2015) published besides the new species *Oreodytes angelinii*, a first record for Greece of a co-occurring species which was given the name *Oreodytes septentrionalis* (Gyllenhal, 1826). Due to several circumstances, which need not be considered here, the choice of this name was incorrect and, accordingly, the first record is incorrect. The correct name of the second species is *Oreodytes davisii davisii* (Curtis, 1831), a species which has already been recorded from Greece.

I thank Fernando Pederzani (Ravenna, Italy) for giving me a hint on the incorrect name. Pederzani claimed also that the name of the river where both species were collected is “Voidomatis” instead of “Viodomatis”.
