
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 392

Coleoptera: Aderidae

Čížek leg. All specimens J. Vávra det. Specimens from Ranšpurk National Nature Reserve, Mikulčice, Kostice and Lanžhot were collected with flight interception traps in floodplain forests along the lower Morava (March) and Dyje (Thaya) rivers.

The nominotypic subspecies is distributed in southern, western and northern Europe, while *V. brevicornis rotundaticollis* Israelson, 1971 is endemic to the Canary Islands (Nardi 2008). In Central Europe, *V. brevicornis brevicornis* has been reported from Germany, Czech Republic (Lohse 1992, Nardi 2008) and Poland (Szołtys 2008, Jałoszyński et al. 2013). In the Czech Republic reported from Bohemia by Klima (1902) and Lohse (1992), but without any further details. Pic (1910) also reported it from Bohemia, but Israelson (1970, 1971) later showed that this record referred to material from Adamov near Brno (coll. Fleischer) in Moravia. In the Check-list of Czechoslovak beetles (Jelínek 1993) the occurrence in Moravia is marked as dubious. Correction of the check-list (Jelínek 1993) and confirmed occurrence in Moravia after approximately 100 years.

Pseudanidorus pentatomus (C. G. Thomson, 1864). Moravia bor. or.: Moravskoslezské Beskydy Mts., Dolní Lomná env., Mionší National Nature Reserve (6478), 790 m a.s.l., 15.–29.vii.2008, 1 ♀, in flight interception trap at ca. 20 m above ground in Abieto-Fagetum, J. Schlaghamerský, D. Hauck & L. Bureš leg. Moravia mer.: Mikulčice (7268), 157 m a.s.l., 13.vii.–1.viii.2012, 1 ♀, in flight interception trap in floodplain forest, Š. Vodka, D. Hauck & L. Čížek leg. Both specimens J. Vávra det. et coll.

European species, in Central Europe known from the Czech Republic, Germany (Nardi 2008) and Poland (Kowalczyk et al. 2002, Jałoszyński et al. 2013). From the Czech Republic reported by Lohse (1992) from Moravia without any further details. This record was thus omitted in the Check-list of Czechoslovak Insects (Jelínek 1993). Correction of the check-list (Jelínek 1993) and first concrete records from the Czech Republic.

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
