
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 400

Diptera: Scathophagidae

Coniosternum mihalyii Šifner, 1975. Bohemia mer., Smrčina Mt. (7249), iv.–20.v.2007, 2 ♀♀; 4.v.–8.vi.2007, 1 ♂, all Malaise traps, R. Mödlinger leg., F. Šifner det. et coll. The description of this species is based on a series of six males and four females from Mongolia (Šifner 1975). One male was in later years recorded from Iraq (Šifner 2008) and one male was determined by Ozerov during a study the type series of *Scatophaga albidohirta* Becker, 1907 from China: Qinghai province (Ozerov & Krivosheina 2011). The discovery of this species is not only the first record from the Czech Republic but from the whole of Europe. **Note.** The male and females were compared with paratypes, taken through the key to species of the genus *Coniosternum* and compared with the figures of this species (Šifner 2013).
