
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM CZECH REPUBLIC– 424

Coleoptera: Histeridae

Abraeus (Postabraeus) parvulus Aubé, 1842. Moravia mer.: Tvrdonice (7268), 48°45'39.715"N 17°1'24.485"E, 17.v.–4.vi.2012, 1 spec., in flight intercept trap on floodplain of lower Morava/Dyje Rivers, Š. Vodka, D. Hauck & L. Čížek lgt., T. Lackner det. et coll., P. Vienna revid. *Abraeus (Postabraeus) parvulus* is an extremely rare species, possibly one of the rarest histerid species in Central Europe. It is found in litter, decaying wood or under bark of deciduous trees, often together with various species of ants (e.g. *Lasius brunneus* (Latreille, 1798)) (Kryzhanovskij & Reichardt 1976). According to Lackner et al. (2015) it is known from Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, France, Germany, Greece, Italy, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia and Sweden. In the Czech Republic, Olexa (1993) reports it only from Bohemia. New species for Moravia.
