
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 446

Coleoptera: Phalacridae

Olibrus norvegicus Munster, 1901. Moravia mer., Bzenec-Prívov, Váté písky Nature Monument (7069), 25.v.2016, in acidophilous sandy xerothermic grassland, on *Crepis* sp., 1 ♂, 1 ♀, J. Januš lgt., det. et coll., Z. Švec revid. Distributed in northern Africa (Algeria), Asia (Far East of Russia, Israel, Turkey, Turkmenistan) and Northern, Central and Southern Europe (Bulgaria, “Caucasus”, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, Germany, Greece, Latvia, Lithuania, the Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Russia: North European Territory (Karelia), Slovakia and Switzerland) (Švec 2007), Austria (Holzer 2007), France (Sainte-Claire Deville 1935–1938) and Great Britain (Telfer 2013). First record for Moravia as well as for the Czech Republic.
