
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 450

Coleoptera: Carabidae

Bembidion (Notaphemphanes) ephippium (Marsham, 1802). Moravia mer., Znojmo env., Šatov – V Pekle (7162), 280 m a.s.l., 27.vii.2012, 1 spec., V. Křivan & A. Reiter lgt., V. Křivan det. et coll. The specimen was collected using a light trap on southern slopes with vineyards, together with other halophilic carabid species *Pogonus luridipennis* (Germar, 1822), *P. peisonis* Ganglbauer, 1891 and *Polistichus connexus* (Geoffroy, 1785).

The species is distributed in Europe, Turkey and North Africa (Marggi et al. 2017). In nearby countries, it is known from Austria, Germany, Hungary, Poland, Slovakia and Slovenia (Hůrka 1996, Vigna Taglianti 2013, Marggi et al. 2017). New species for the Czech Republic.
