
FAUNISTICS RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 452

Hymenoptera:

Braconidae

Helcon claviventris Wesmael, 1835. Bohemia centr., Křivoklátsko Protected Landscape Area (PLA), Lány (5849), 4.vii.2010, 1 ♀, window trap, K. Rébl lgt.; Moravia mer., Moravský kras PLA, Bílovice nad Svitavou, Hádecká planinka National Nature Reserve (6766), 14.vi.2011, 1 ♀, K. Holý lgt., both K. Holý det. et coll. In Central Europe, known from Austria, Germany, Hungary, Poland and Switzerland (Yu et al. 2016). New species for the Czech Republic.

Helconidea ruspator (Linnaeus, 1758). Moravia mer.: Bobrava (6865), 4.vii.1949, 1 ♀, J. Šnoflák lgt., Hranice (6472), 3.viii.1923, 1 ♀, V. Zavadil lgt.; Rožná u Perštejna (6563), 26.vii.1928, 1 ♀, V. Zavadil lgt.; Ubušín (6363), 23.vii.1925, 1 ♀, 19.viii.1939, 1 ♀, both F. Gregor sen. lgt.; Valašské Meziříčí (6573), 27.vii.1912, 1 ♀, V. Zavadil lgt., all J. Šnoflák det., K. Holý revid., coll. Moravian Museum, Brno. In the most recent checklist, reported only from Slovakia (Čapek & Lukáš 1989). Known from all surrounding countries (Yu et al. 2016). New species for the Czech Republic.

Sigalphus irrorator (Fabricius, 1775). Moravia, 1 ♀, J. Slaviček lgt. (on the label only: “Morava, Slaviček”). In the Slaviček collection there are additional 2 ♂♂ without any label and 1 ♀ with a label with the number 190. All four specimens probably originate from Central Moravia (Litovel, Bouzov, Konice), where Slaviček worked as a teacher (Kolečka 1993). All specimens J. Slaviček lgt., K. Holý revid., coll. Moravian Museum, Brno. In the most recent checklist, reported only from Slovakia (Čapek & Lukáš 1989). Known from all surrounding countries (Yu et al. 2016). New species for the Czech Republic.

Aulacidae

Pristaulacus patrati (Audinet-Serville, 1833). Moravia mer., Šumná (7061), 15.vii.2009, 1 ♀, K. Holý lgt., det. et coll. In Europe known only from Austria, France, Germany, Hungary, Spain and Switzerland (Turrisi 2007). New species for the Czech Republic.

Cynipidae

Andricus aries (Giraud, 1859). Bohemia centr., Hradištko by Sadská, near the cemetery (5855), 4.v.2010, 3 galls on *Quercus* sp., K. Holý lgt., det. et coll. Known from all surrounding countries (Forshage & Ronquist 2018). In the Czech Republic known only from Moravia (Mikula 1989). New species for Bohemia.

Andricus dentimitratus (Rejtö, 1887). Moravia mer.: Pouzdřany (7065), 22.xi.2007, 1 gall, 26.vi.2010, 1 gall on *Quercus* sp., both K. Holý lgt., det. et coll.; Zlín (6771–6772), 14.viii.2015, 1 gall photographed by J. Bernatík, K. Holý det., gall pictures available at www.klapalekiana.cz.

biolib.cz. In Central Europe known only from Austria and Hungary (Forshage & Ronquist 2018). From the Czech Republic reported by Holý (2011) from Podyjí National Park. The new records document the expansion of this species to the north.

Andricus multiplicatus Giraud, 1859. Bohemia centr.: Český kras PLA, Hostim, Karlštejn – Pšánův kout (6050), 26.vii.2012, tens of galls observ.; Oškobrh, Oškobrh hill (5857), 27.vii.2010, hundreds of galls observ., 2 galls lgt., 25.ix.2012, hundreds of galls observ.; Žehuň, Žehuňská obora, Kněžičky National Nature Reserve (5857), 26.v.2012, tens of galls observ., all galls on *Quercus cerris*, all K. Holý observ., lgt., det. et coll. In Central Europe known from Austria, Hungary and Slovakia (Forshage & Ronquist 2018). In the Czech Republic known only from Moravia (Mikula 1989). New species for Bohemia.

Periclistus brandtii (Ratzeburg, 1831). Bohemia centr.: Kokořínsko – Máchův kraj PLA, Dolní Zimor, Želízky (5553), 24.iv.2005, 1 ♂, 2 ♀♀; České středohoří PLA, Chraberce, Oblík hill National Nature Reserve (5548), 20.ix.2012, 3 ♂♂, 7 ♀♀; Litoměřice, apricot orchard (5450), 23.iii.2004, 1 ♂, 6 ♀♀; Bohemia or., Ostružno (6159), 20.iv.2003, 1 ♀, all hatched from *Diplolepis rosae* (Linnaeus, 1758) galls, all K. Holý lgt., det. et coll. Known from all surrounding countries (Mikula 1989, Forshage & Ronquist 2018). In the Czech Republic known only from Moravia (Mikula 1989). New species for Bohemia.

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
