Coleoptera: Staphylinidae: Aleocharinae

Ilyobates mech (Baudi di Selve, 1848). Moravia bor. or., Moravskoslezské Beskydy mts., Morávka-Úspolka (6152), 13.v.–3.vi.2018, 1 ♀, in pitfall trap in mixed forest, J. Stanovský lgt. and coll., L. Koloničný det. Widespread throughout east and central Europe, reported from Austria, Croatia, France, Germany, Hungary, Italy, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Switzerland and the Caucasus (Schülke & Smetana 2015). In the Czech Republic only published from Bohemia: Praha-Klánovice by Boháč & Matějček (2003). New species for Moravia.
