
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 462

Coleoptera: Nitidulidae

Brassicogethes reitteri (Schilsky, 1894). Moravia bor. or., Bukovec env., Bukovec Nature Reserve (6479), 1.vi.2015, 1 spec., sweeping on peat meadow, R. Szopa leg. et coll., J. Jelínek det.

Species with discontinuous distribution in the mountains of South and southern Central Europe from the Pyrenees and Cantabrian mountains to the Caucasus, northwards to Belgium, Switzerland, Germany, Ukraine, and Romania, Central Asia (Altai) and Siberia (Jelínek & Audisio 2007). Host plants are species of the botanical genus *Hesperis* (Brassicaceae) (Audisio 1993). New species for the Czech Republic.
