
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 474

Coleoptera: Oedemeridae

Oedemera nobilis (Scopoli, 1763). Moravia bor.: Krnov (5972), 8.v.2007, 1 ♀, N. Görtler leg., M. Zúber det. et coll.

Distributed in Europe: Mediterranean Region, northwards to England and Denmark and in Africa: Algeria, Morocco and Tunisia (Švihla 2008). In central Europe known from Austria, Germany and Switzerland (Kubisz & Švihla 2013). In the Czech Republic recorded from Bohemia: Chlum u Třeboně by Ernest (2017). New species for Moravia, probably indicating continued expansion of this species.
