
FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 538

Coleoptera: Carabidae

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Bembidion (Emphanes) axillare euxinum Apfelbeck, 1904. Moravia mer., Rakvice env., Trkmanský Dvůr (7167a), 48°51'40"N 16°50'18"E, 165 m a.s.l., 30.vii.2021, 1 ♀, at a UV light trap on a salt marsh in the southwestern part of Trkmanec-Rybníčky Natural Monument, J. Kovář leg., M. Linhart det. et coll.

Four subspecies are reported in the range of this species, two of them known from Europe: *B. axillare occiduum* Marggi et Huber, 2001 from Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, France, Hungary, Italy, Portugal, Romania, Slovenia, and Spain and *B. axillare euxinum* Apfelbeck, 1904 from Armenia, Bulgaria, Georgia, Greece, Moldavia, Russia (South European Territory), Ukraine, Serbia, and Montenegro (Marggi et al. 2017), and also from Slovakia (Petr Veselý pers. comm. 2023, unpublished records from three localities). The classification to the published subspecies was also based on information on the determination of Hungarian and Slovak specimens as *B. axillare euxinum* Apfelbeck, 1904 (K. Rébl, pers. comm. 2023). For this reason, and from the distribution of two subspecies in Europe, which does not correspond to a macropterous and highly mobile species, is apparent that a taxonomic revision is needed. New species for the Czech Republic.
